RRSP	Official receipts for March 2, 2019 and the first 60 days of 2020 Receipts for other periods will be subject to correction	<input type="checkbox"/>
Charitable donations	Official receipts from charities recognized by the CRA and RQ	<input type="checkbox"/>
Support payments	Proof of payment of support for the former spouse and not for the children, if the support is deductible	<input type="checkbox"/>
T2201	Disability credit (ADHD, Type 1 diabetes, physical or intellectual disability, mental illness, etc.)	<input type="checkbox"/>
First Home Credit	Date of purchase of the first home for a new owner	<input type="checkbox"/>
Legal fees	Legal fees for alimony (if applicable). Specific rules apply and are subject to regular audit by the tax authorities. Thus, fee notes must be detailed and accurate to be eligible for deduction	<input type="checkbox"/>
Medical expenses	Receipts for eligible medical expenses, proof of payment of health-related insurance premiums excluding salary insurance if this information is not reported on the T4 slip (box85)	<input type="checkbox"/>
